IOSCO COUNTY FAIR
COMBINE DEMOLITION DERBY
Wednesday July 28, 7:00 P.M.

1. Driver is required to fill out an entry form, which includes a waiver of liability.
2. All drivers must be at least 18 years of age or accompanied by a guardian.
3. Fair officials have the right to reject any and all entries.
4. Number must be painted on top and both sides of combine.
5. No radios for driver communication allowed.
6. Female drivers may not participate if pregnant.
7. All combines must be inspected and approved by derby officials.
8. Alcohol or drug use is prohibited before or during the event and is grounds for immediate rejection.
9. No offensive language or pictures on combines will be permitted.
10. The decision of the officials is final and cannot be appealed.
11. No teaming, everyone for themselves.
12. Disconnect all drive belts to the threshing unit, grain table, (only the transmission can be connected)
13. Fuel tank must be mounted in the grain tank.
14. Cab doors must be welded and/or bolted shut.
15. All glass must be removed including lights.
16. Driver ladders must be removed.
17. Remove unloading auger from grain tank.
18. No reinforcement plates or shields may be added to protect the transmission, drive belts, or tires.
19. Batteries must be securely mounted where they cannot be hit. (best on top of combine near motor)
20. Install welded bars to cab at least 2 feet up from driver platform, (the more protection the better).
21. No weight can be added.
22. Tires are to be "stock" and nothing but air used to inflate them. No liquids or foams!
23. Rear tires may be turned around or "dished out" for a wider stance as long as they are the stock wheels.
24. Rear axle can be welded so that it does not pivot up and down.
25. No corn heads.
26. No rear wheel assist. 4 wheel drive must be disabled.
27. Grain table must be used, if torn off the unit is disqualified. Weld it to the combine.
28. Remove reel, sickle bar, guards, and floating cutter bar.
29. Head must be a minimum of 10 feet.
30. Ends of head must be cut off even with front edge of grain table (where guards were attached).
31. Head must be fastened solid to the combine between 18-24" from the front edge of grain table to the ground.
32. Hydraulic hoses to the head cylinders must be removed and head welded in a fixed position or the hydraulic cylinders replaced with solid braces.

33. **Judges decision as to the safety and operation of each combine is final.**
34. No direct hits to the driver area.
35. No lifting another combine off the ground.
36. No hitting a combine after it is out.
37. Time limit is 3 minutes from start to make a hit.
38. No hitting with the rear of the combine (must be moving forward to make a hit).
39. All combines must stop immediately when warning signal is given.
40. All drivers must wear a DOT approved helmet.
41. All drivers must wear a seat belt.
42. **Clear any "inventive idea" with the demo officials before you do it. This demo is for fun and to compete equally and as safely as possible. Therefore you may be illegal.**
43. **Combine and all parts must be cleaned up and removed from the fairgrounds by noon Sunday, August 2nd.**
